Itinerary

Day 1:

JOHANNESBURG - TEL AVIV

Meet at the International Departure Hall of O.R.Tambo International Airport at 16:30. Departure is for Tel Aviv over Cairo Overnight on BOARD (D* B*)

Day 2:

Cairo - Tel Aviv - Caesarea - Tiberias.

Early morning touch-down at Cairo at 05:35 where we'll be connected to the flight for **Tel Aviv**. Upon arrival at 10:15 in Tel Aviv, first of all we visit **Caesarea**. There we see the impressive Roman amphitheatre and see the ancient Crusader fortifications built in 1251AD. This was the home town of Cornelius (Acts 10:22-24; 34-48) and Philip (Acts 8:40). Paul was brought to Caesarea after his capture (Acts 23:23-33). There is still a huge theater - Roman Style. We'll continue to **Nazareth**. In Nazareth we visit Joseph's Grotto and Mary's Well. Jesus lived here for about 30 years - so called Jesus of Nasareth. Then pass **Cana** to **Tiberias** at the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Day 3: GALILEE -

Travel to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where the Sermon on the Mount was delivered. Visit the Church of Beatitudes and **Tabga**, where the multiplication of the bread and fish took place.. Continue to **Mensa Christi** where Jesus appeared to his disciples and they had a meal together (John 21:1). At **Capernaum** we see the ruins of a second-century Synagogue, as well as the excavations of St. Peter's house. Visit the so called "**Jesus boat**" museum. This boat was only recently discovered in some shallow water on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.. Enjoy **a boat trip this before lunch**. on the Sea of Galilee with some time for reflection. Fish lunch at the lake. Visit mount **Tabor** as the mount of transfiguration in the afternoon by taxi. Overnight in Tiberias. (B, D)

Day 4: BETHLEHEM -JERUSALEM

Today we'll travel through the **Jordan Valley** visit **Jericho**. Then **Betabara** at the river Jordan where John baptised the Lord - Baptismal renewal. We'll visit **Qumran** (Video) and then have time to swim in **the Dead Sea**. This sea is formed by the waters of the River Jordan and several smaller streams entering it, but has no exit. The waters contain billions of tons of valuable chemicals. The water is five times saltier than the ocean. Unique healing qualities are found in the mud along the shore. In the Bible it was known as the "Salt Sea". In Bethlehem we'll visit the Church of Birth, seen as one of the oldest in history. It is built on the cave where it is believed Jesus was born. Dinner and overnight **in Bethlehem**

Day 5: JERUSALEM

We have time for shopping at a large Olive-wood factory shop **Three Arches**. Drive to **Jerusalem**. Visit the Mount of Olives from where Christ sent his disciples to get the donkey on which He ride into Jerusalem (Luke 19:28-44). From the summit one has a wonderful view of the old city of Jerusalem and the temple area. A group photo will be taken. Spend some time in the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus prayed (Luke 22:39-44) and Judas betrayed Him. The **Church of All Nations** is in this garden with old Olive trees still growing here. Visit the house of Kajafas, also known as **St. Peter in Gallicantu**. It is here that Peter denied Christ three times (Matt. 26:57 - 27:2). Gallicantu means "the crowing of the cock" Thereafter we'll visit the **wailing wall and the Jewish Quarter** and end the day with a visit to **the upper Room**. Overnight in Jerusalem (B,D)

Day 6 Jerusalem

Today well start to walk through the **St Stefens Gate** into to the Old City. We visit the **Baths of Bethesda** where Jesus healed a cripple man. We walk the **Via Dolorosa up Golgotha**. We visit the **Garden Tomb** at **16:00**. A Christian Embassy guide will assist in a tour of the grounds which has a beautiful view of Golgotha, also known as Gordon's Calvary. Holy Communion will be served in the grounds of the Garden Tomb. Return to Jerusalem to have the Dinner and overnight (B)(D)

Day 7: JERUSALEM - CAIRO

After breakfast we'll be transferred for the flight **to Cairo** at 11:05 On arrival at 12:30 well meet our Egyptian guide The famous **Egyptian museum** is on our itinerry for the day . Thereafter well have dinner at a restaurant and be transferred to our hotel in Cairo for overnight (B,D)

Day 8: CAIRO

After breakfast enjoy a tour of the **Great Pyramids and the Sphinx** in Giza. Visit the **factory shops for perfume, leather** etc. In the afternoon well have lunch and visit the market for last minute shopping. A Felucca sunset sailing on the river Nile will end the tour in Cairo before transfered to the airport for our flight back to South Africa.(B)(D)

Day 9: JOHANNESBURG

Arrival at **O.R.Tambo** International Airport at 07:05 (B*) after a wonderfull trip together in the Holy Land. Breakfast on board. (B)

4. All prices are ex-departure point indicated in the tour programme and based on prices and rates of exchange ruling at the time of preparation of the document in which the quotation is made and are subject to increase without notice. All prices quoted are per person sharing.
